



We've been a Boxer family since 2001. Our first rescue was a little girl we named Grace that we adopted while living in Texas in 2014. Besides being a perfect ambassador for rescue, she was my running buddy, my heart, and my spirit. I sadly lost her very suddenly to a heart condition at age 6 in the summer of 2018. By November 2018, our house was complete again with the adoption of two dogs from the local Humane Society - a Plott mix we named Annie, (age 5), and our current Boxer, Frank, (almost 9). We also have a 10-year old rescue cat named Blaze. We are now a forever-rescue family. I like to think that Grace's legacy lives on in that way.

When RCBR first began, I was invited by one of the founding members to volunteer. Having four kids and a full-time job, I didn't have a ton of extra time (or money) but felt I could help by writing grants. My role has expanded somewhat since 2019 in that in addition to grant writing and coordinating, I currently serve as a Board Member as well as assisting with transports when they pass through our area in River Falls, Wisconsin. Volunteering with RCBR is important to me for many reasons, but I am especially proud of the fact that we focus our rescue work on those that are most often overlooked, forgotten, or discarded - senior and special needs Boxers. Every Boxer, regardless of age or ability, deserves a loving home for their forever; no matter whether that "forever" is years, weeks, or days. I am proud to be part of a group that makes sure that happens for this special population.

You were a typical, slobbering beautiful Boxer boy and you are so sorely missed. RCBR sprung you from the shelter after a month, and placed vou in an awesome foster home for almost two more months. We adopted you on May 15 and you quickly claimed our hearts. Your heartworm infestation wound up being a rare case of Caval Syndrome. Healing thoughts, prayers and a veterinary team willing to try non-invasive treatments got that under control so you were started down the path of heartworm treatment. Other issues began showing up, including tremors, seizures and aggression. After eight and a half weeks, we realized something was very wrong deep down inside, and you needed to be free of it all. We helped you cross the Rainbow Bridge, hoping you knew you were loved and were not responsible for whatever transpired before we knew you. Run free,

Crying as I'm writing this. She was a good baby and she meant something to us.




Ross 7/26/21
