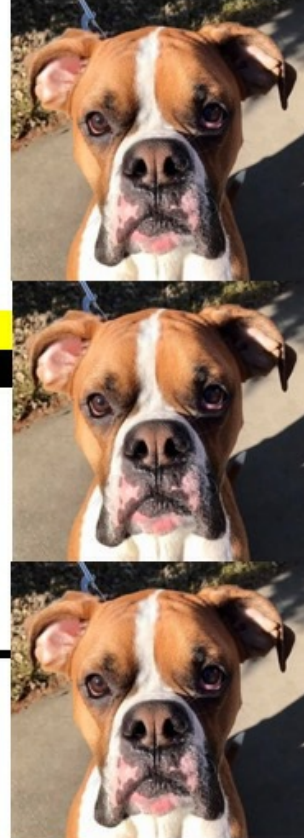

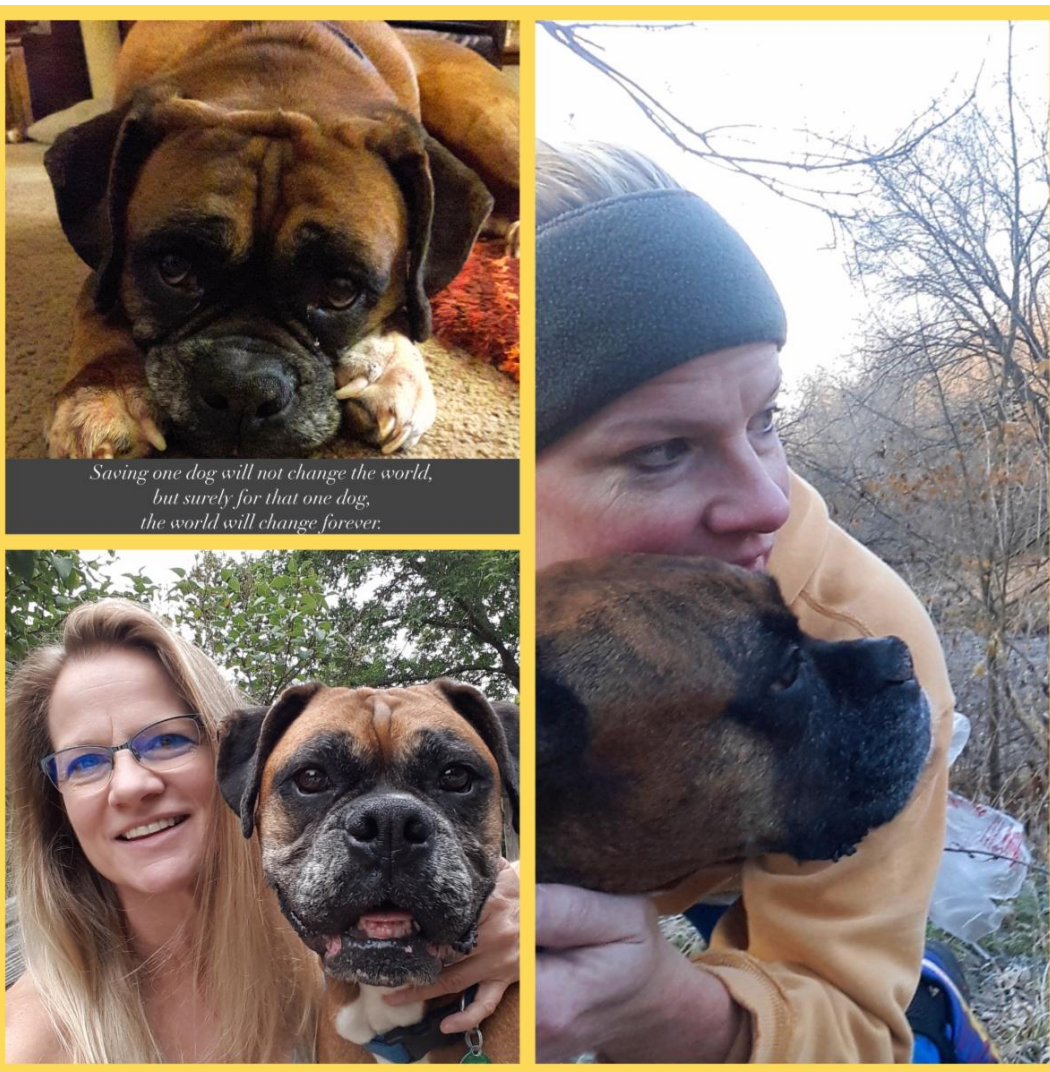

We've been a Boxer family since 2001. Our first rescue was a little girl we named Grace that we adopted while living in Texas in 2014. Besides being a perfect ambassador for rescue, she was my running buddy, my heart, and my spirit. I sadly lost her very suddenly to a heart condition at age 6 in the summer of 2018. By November 2018, our house was complete again with the adoption of two dogs from the local Humane Society - a Plott mix we named Annie, (age 5), and our current Boxer, Frank, (almost 9). We also have a 10-year old rescue cat named Blaze. We are now a forever-rescue family. I like to think that Grace's legacy lives on in that way.

When RCBR first began, I was invited by one of the founding members to volunteer. Every Boxer, regardless of age or ability, deserves a loving home for their forever; no matter whether that "forever" is years, weeks, or days. I am proud to be part of a group that makes sure that happens for this special population.

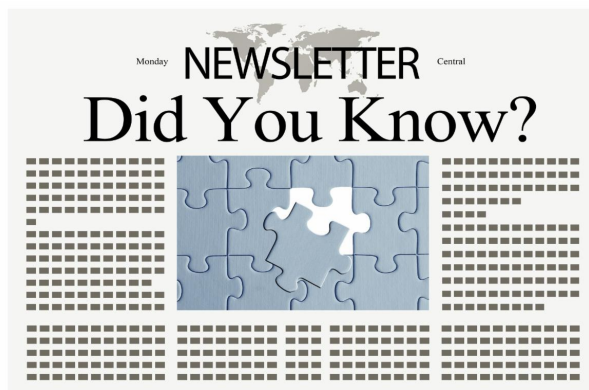

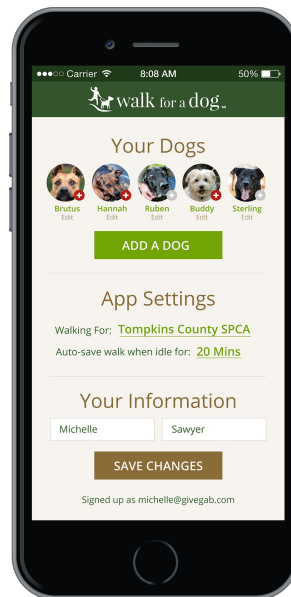
